

Otalama Residents Happily Welcomed Packages From The Indonesian Chief Of Army Delivered By The Habema

NDUGA- One of the military units under the command of the Indonesian Armed Forces Operational Command HABEMA, the Task Forces of the Para Raider Infantry Battalion 432/Waspada Setia Jaya Kostrad, is currently conducting mobile security at the border of Indonesia and Papua New Guinea, especially in Nduga Regency, Papua Pegunungan Province. On Wednesday, 9 October 2024.

The 432 Task Forces, especially the Mbuwa Post led by First Lieutenant Fahrizal, conducted Social Communication (Komsos) with residents of Otalama Village, Mbuwa District, while conducting areal protection tasks.
